The applicants must satisfy the following criteria:

- Be a resident of or have been a resident of the Southern San Joaquin Valley (Fresno County south).
- Must be at least a graduating senior in 2017, and 18 years of age by June 5, 2017.
- Be enrolled or accepted in an agriculture or related curriculum at a Community College, State College or University.
- Must be a citizen of the United States.

The selected intern will work in all aspects of production agriculture and will be under the supervision of the Cooperative Extension Farm Advisors in Kern County. The selected intern will receive full-time compensation of approximately \$2,200 per month. The position is not benefited.
