Do not bring sick animals to the show, and remember to bring water for goats and goat owners. Uniforms are recommended (no shorts or tank tops for showmanship). A snack bar will be open in the Livestock Pavilion.

7:30-8:30 am-Check In for showmanship classes, costume contest, obstacle course, and photo contest.

8:15-8:40. Grooming Clinic. See what you need to do to prepare your goat to show at the fair.

8:45-9:15 Novice Showmanship Clinic for beginners. Bring your showmanship goat and lead.

9:15-9:45 Advanced Showmanship Clinic. Bring your showmanship goat and lead

9:45 Senior Showmanship, followed by Intermediate, Junior, and Mini Showmanship. Prizes given out for 1st-5th place in each division.

11:00ish-Hula on over to our **Pygmy Costume Contest**. Photo taken with backdrop and props for those who participate and prize drawing.

**Pygmy Obstacle Course**- Popsicles for those who participate and prize drawing.

**Pygmy Photo Contest**-Cookies for those who participate and prize drawing.
