Learn about identification, biology, ecology, control, and regulations for management of aquatic weeds

The Aquatic Weed School 2012 is an intensive two-day course focusing on issues associated with developing weed management strategies in a variety of aquatic ecosystems. The course provides a rare opportunity for professionals to efficiently update their understanding of aquatic weeds and interact with experts in this field. The Aquatic Weed School is designed for those involved in consulting, research, and management of aquatic weed systems throughout the western United States.

Topics include:

ecological classification and impacts of aquatic weeds • biology of aquatic weeds • physical and chemical characteristics of aquatic ecosystems • regulatory issues [update on National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permitting Program • prevention strategies • CDFA aquatic plant eradication programs • legal aspects of the Endangered Species Act (ESA) • aquatic weed ID • outdoor application equipment • adjuvants and surfactants for aquatic systems • water management for aquatic weed control • decision making process for selection of appropriate management options • physical and mechanical control methods • biological and chemical controls • principles of restoration for ecologically-based invasive weed management • restoration and sustainable ecosystem management

The topics are presented in lecture, laboratory and demonstration formats. Each attendee will receive a comprehensive course notebook with lecture notes and additional information.
