## **ELIGIBILITY**

The Kern County Cattle Women are currently offering several Ruth Smoot-French Memorial Scholarships to graduating high school seniors, and current college and university students whose primary residence is in Kern County. Students must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 or better. Applicants <u>must</u> also fit in at least one of the following categories:

- 1. KCCW Relative: This scholarship is open to any student who is a relative of a Kern County Cattle Woman member in good standing, regardless of major.
