Adult 4-H volunteers are invited to participate in the field-testing of an updated online version of the food safety curriculum “Make It Safe, Keep It Safe”. The field-testing will be carried out through a basic web-based delivery. The feedback will help inform the version for the final enhanced delivery method.

For field-testing, the information needed include: email address, name, and county. This information is needed as soon as possible, as the pilot testing only runs through the end of July! The estimated time to complete the training is 45 minutes to 1 hour. The evaluation will provide the study team with feedback on improving the training.
